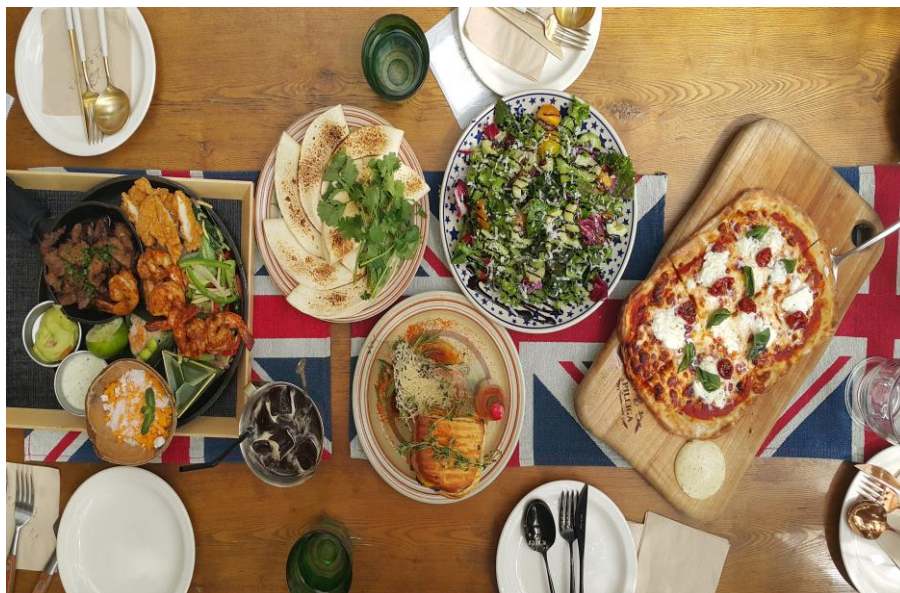




ROSEBUD COMMUNITY GARDEN
