Committee meeting starts at 10am

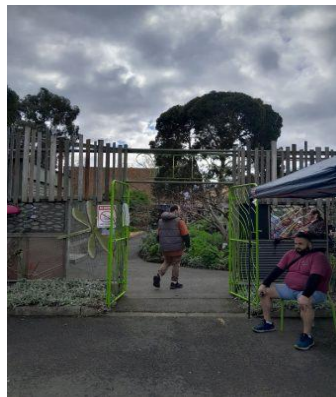
Working Bee from 11.00am
